### Waiouru Road – new development.

You may have noticed two new facilities going up on Waiouru Road next to the Highbrook Park walking track. Fackelmann, one of Highbrook's long standing customers and a global supplier of kitchenware, bakeware, knives and glassware is moving from Highbrook Drive. ### Highbrook's ecosystem just got a boost with the addition of honeybees, in an area now called Hivebrook.

By introducing hives, the bees are helping to pollinate plants and promote biodiversity. This, in addition to the new ngahere (native plants) in the parklands, is creating a habitat and foodsource for insects and birds. The ngahere has seating and a lovely rest area to take time out.

Hivebrook is located next to the storm-water pond on the corner of Highbrook Drive and Business Parade North.

The ngahere is across the road down Tāwharau Lane.

Goodman has been working with Wilson Parking to provide more flexible short term parking options at Highbrook to cater for your morning, lunchbreak and evenings.


The parking, marked in blue will have **90 minutes of free parking!** Plenty of time to sit down and enjoy a meal.
