Let's go sustainable

Goodman is working with customers to lower operating emissions and improve the resource efficiency of warehouse facilities.

Sharing a vision for lower emissions and more resilient buildings, Goodman is progressively upgrading facilities, improving the environmental performance and reducing operating costs.

Key improvements:

- Solar energy systems to provide customers with onsite renewable power.
- New generation LED fittings which are up to 75% more efficient than incandescent bulbs and last 25 times longer than traditional lighting. They can be fully automated with occupancy sensors to minimise energy consumption and significantly reduce occupancy costs.
- EV chargers and dedicated charging bays for electric forklifts to reduce the carbon footprint, with bike racks providing a more active commuting option for staff.

- Electrical submetering to provide accurate, real-time energy monitoring to minimise energy consumption and allowing energy benchmarking across multiple facilities.
- Beehives within the landscaped property or wider estate to provide the community with greater biodiversity.

"These upgrades create a more sustainable property solution for our customers. More resource efficient, it is reducing the customers carbon emissions with superior workspaces that contribute to greater productivity and reduced operating costs."

Where: 29 Pukekiwiriki Place, Highbrook Park



Highbrook's ecosystem just got a boost with the addition of honeybees, in an area now called Hivebrook.

By introducing hives, the bees are helping to pollinate plants and promote biodiversity. This, in addition to the ngahere (native plants) in the parklands, is creating a habitat and foodsource for insects and birds. The ngahere has seating and a lovely rest area to take time out.

Sara (The Bee Lady NZ) has been working hard to keep our hives and our bees happy and healthy, and collects the raw honey from the hives.

Our bees are doing such an awesome job at Hivebrook that they have produced some delicious Wildflower honey that you can buy! It's great honey at a great price – only \$8 for 500 gm pot of Pure, Raw, Multifloral honey.

In addition to Wildflower, Beelady has several other honeys made from hives in Tāmaki Makaurau and wider North Island. Here is the full range (500 gm jars):
