HIGHBROOK PARKLANDS Revitalising our ecology

The Ōtara Waterways and Lake Trust is a charitable organisation committed to restoring the mauri (life force) of the Ōtara waterways and reconnecting the community with their local creeks and streams. Established in June 2016, the Trust emerged from the Placemaking: Ōtara Waterways and Lake Steering Group, which included over 20 organisations and individuals passionate about cleaning up the Ōtara creek and waterway system which includes Tāmaki River.

Three sections of bank were prepared for planting. The wall of weeds in the distance is next on the list for the coastal restoration project Spicers team of volunteers being briefed before the first of two plantings. Over 40 staff participated in the planting along their boundary.



Coastal Weed Clearance and Native Planting at Highbrook Parklands

A few months ago, the Trust, in collaboration with Spicers NZ at Highbrook, undertook a significant project at Highbrook Parklands. This initiative focused on coastal weed clearance and native planting, aiming to enhance the ecological health of the area. By removing invasive species and planting native flora, the Trust is working to restore the natural biodiversity and beauty of Highbrook Parklands.

Predator Control at the Crater

In addition to their planting efforts, the Ōtara Waterways and Lake Trust has recently taken over predator control responsibilities at the crater in Highbrook Parklands from Goodman. This initiative is crucial for protecting native wildlife from predators and ensuring the sustainability of the local ecosystem, allowing native species to thrive.

A Vision for the Future

Banks along the coastal margin were cleared of thick tree weed cover before planting could start. Tall privet and wattle trees, mature woolly nightshade, gorse bushes, pampas clumps, blackberry vines, bone seed and many other species have taken over the banks and created an environment that is hostile to native animal and plant life.
