
### Welcome to the winter issue of the Highbrook Magazine!



# Highbrook Watersports Centre gets closer to completion!

In 2007, a study conducted by the Auckland Regional Council highlighted a significant shortage of facilities to support flat water sporting codes (waka ama, rowing, canoeing and dragon boating) in Auckland, particularly South and East Auckland.

Public access to the 400-hectare Tāmaki River recreation area was primarily from the northern shore.

A sponsorship from Goodman, owner and manager of Highbrook Business Park, was the catalyst to transform the concept of the Highbrook Regional Watersports Centre (Watersports Centre) into reality. This support was reinforced by contributions from other Highbrook businesses including Cottonsoft, NXP, Fraser Thomas, Spicers NZ and Metroglass, as well as Hynds located nearby in East Tāmaki.

With an investment of \$4 million in private and public funds, the site development began, including the construction of carparks, retaining walls, building platforms, services, a boat ramp, and a pontoon. In 2021, the project team formed a Charitable Trust known as the Highbrook Regional Watersports Centre Trust. The trustees include representatives from iwi, rowing, and waka ama, namely Jada MacFie, Barry Brown, Heremaia Rosieur, Peter Moody, and chaired by Murdoch Dryden.

The Charitable Trust has been actively fundraising and planning, achieving significant milestones such as the finalisation of the building design, receipt of building consent, and raising over 85% of the required budget to complete the targeted building works.

With an expected completion date of mid-2026, the Trust engaged in discussions with several schools whose paddling programs would use the Watersports Centre.

As the Watersports Centre moves closer to becoming a reality, the community's continued support and engagement will be crucial in ensuring the successful completion and operation of this vital facility.

### Skills Hub Officially Opens Boosting Auckland's Trades Sector

A cutting-edge trades teaching and training facility which has officially opened here at Highbrook, is set to unlock educational opportunities across Auckland and fuel growth in the trades industry.

The opening was marked with a symbolic wire-cutting ceremony — a nod to the electrical trade — led by 24-year-old student Georgia Rensen who recently qualified as an electrician. Georgia's role in the ceremony highlighted the growing presence and importance of women in trades.

The event was also attended by the Hon. Erica Stanford, Minister of Education and Minister of Immigration, who officially opened the new 3,300-square-metre, two-storey campus - a major milestone for Skills Group, New Zealand's largest private training establishment.

Previously a logistics warehouse, the building has undergone a \$4.5 million transformation into a modern learning hub, now dedicated to training students in the electrical trades.

Skills Group Director Trades School, Di Lithgow, says the new campus reflects the organisation's commitment to delivering contemporary and effective training environments

The Highbrook facility, located at 18 Business Parade North, follows recent expansions by Skills Group in Christchurch and Dunedin, bringing world-class training environments to key regions across the country.





"This facility, represents a significant boost in our capacity to support the growing demand for skilled tradespeople across Auckland, It's designed to meet the needs of both students and the wider industry through innovative, hands-on learning."

Designed using feedback from tutors and drawing on international best practice, the new campus features state-of-the-art workshop classrooms for pre-trade students.

These spaces combine theory and practice in one cohesive environment.

"Students don't have to leave the classroom to apply what they've learned," Di says.

"They can immediately work on training boards within the same space, creating a seamless learning experience."

Workshops are equipped with customdesigned U-shaped benches that allow students to sit or stand while learning about appliances, soldering, and other practical components. This layout also enables tutors to maintain full visibility and engagement with the entire class from a central position.

"We are incredibly proud to offer this world-class facility in Auckland - one that supports not only our apprentices but also their employers and the broader industry," Di says.





### NABERSNZ TOOL

NABERSNZ is a system for rating the energy efficiency of office buildings. Managed by the New Zealand Green Building Council on behalf of the government, it assesses a building's performance using 12 months of energy data to assign a star rating between 0 and 6. A rating is valid for 1 year, to encourage continuous monitoring and improvement. A 6 Star NABERSNZ rating is the highest possible rating, signifying that the performance of the building is world leading. Holding this rating is a significant achievement, signaling that the building is highly efficient and performing at its best.

This tool helps occupying businesses understand and improve their energy efficiency, thereby reducing their carbon footprint.

For the commercial-use buildings at Highbrook, Goodman targeted NABERSNZ 5 to 6 Star ratings, these efforts align with our broader sustainability goals, including reducing carbon emissions and enhancing energy efficiency.




